

# NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Proposals for professional engineering services for an arsenic treatment system to be installed at Municipal Water Supply Wells 1 and 2 will be received at the Town of Bernalillo Office of Planning and Capital Programs, Town Hall, 829 Camino del Pueblo, Bernalillo, NM until 3:00pm, Wednesday, March 31, 2010 at which time said proposals will be opened and recorded as received. Award consideration will be at the next scheduled Town Council meeting after evaluation and negotiations are complete. A Pre-Proposal Conference will be held at 2:00pm on March 19, 2010 at the Town Hall.

The envelope containing the completed Proposal for Professional Engineering Services must be marked "Request for Proposal - Town of Bernalillo Professional Engineering Services for Municipal Water Supply Wells 1 & 2 Arsenic Treatment Project.

Any contract or contracts awarded under this request for proposals are expected to be funded from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) American Recovery and Reinvestment Act and therefore must comply with all federal cross cutter requirements. Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies or employees is or will be a party to this invitation for proposals or any resulting contract.

All qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, or national origin. Applicants on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246, as amended.

Applicant shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin or sex in the performance of this contract. The applicant shall carry out applicable requirements of 40 CFR part 33 in the award and administration of contracts awarded under EPA financial assistance agreements. Failure by the bidder to carry out these requirements is a material breach of this contract which may result in the termination of this contract or other legally available remedies.

In order to be in compliance with applicable Federal Statutes, Authorities and President's Executive Orders, Bidders' Certifications and Acknowledgments are required. A list of suggested forms for certifications and acknowledgments are in the EPA Region 6 Model Contract Clause for Federally Assisted Water/Wastewater Infrastructure.
