35 Conditional Use Permit for Plaza Miranda development would be considered “dead”; and that
36 any future development plans would have to be submitted under a new appropriate application.
37 Mr. Sapien stated that he understood these implications clearly, and still wished to withdrawal
38 his Application for Appeal. He further stated that he would not be attending the Council meeting
39 because of his withdrawal.
