APPROVAL OF AGENDA: 4a)

Councilor Jaramillo moved to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilor Prairie and the motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: 5a) Regular Meeting of May 28, 2013

Councilor Sisneros moved to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilor Montoya and the motion carried unanimously.

FINANCIAL SECTION: 6a) Approval of Accounts Payable Voucher List.

Mayor Torres asked for a motion to approve the accounts payable voucher list in the amount of \$150,019.16.

Councilor Prairie made a motion to approve the accounts payable voucher list in the amount of \$150,019.16. The motion was seconded by Councilor Jaramillo and the motion carried unanimously.

MISCELLANEOUS SECTION: 7a) Public Comment. Presenter: Mayor Torres

Mayor Torres welcomed the public to speak.

Porter Dees stated that he has made several complaints about several properties in his neighborhood which is on Calle Montoya and has received no response.

Mayor Torres apologized for staff not responding to Mr. Dees but requested Mr. Dees to send

47 information on the properties to him. He will have code enforcement look at the properties. One
48 issue the Town staff does have is some of these properties have been cited into Municipal Court.
49 The Governing Body has no control over what the court does or does not do to the individuals in
50 violation. The law is real clear that the Governing Body has no control over what the Judge does
51 or does not do. Staff is looking at a way to maybe changing our ordinances to address the issue.

53 Porter Dees also had a question on the flood insurance and there is no base elevation study for
54 the Town of Bernalillo.

56 Mayor Torres stated that everyone that lives in Bernalillo is in the same category when it comes
57 to Flood Insurance. After Katrina, Bernalillo Levy's were put into the category as decertified.
58 This was done without anyone coming and actually looking at our community. Since then
59 ESCAFCA has received some money a core sampling has been done on the Levy. The
60 information we have received is that the Levy's will not pass the test. We are working with the
61 Corp of Engineers to see if the Town of Bernalillo can get out of that Flood Zone so our residents
62 to not have to pay the high cost of Flood Insurance. Also, ESCAFCA is working with the Corp of
63 Engineers with information for other options that are cost effective for the Town that FEMA will
64 accept on the Levy.

66 **MISCELLANEOUS SECTION: 7b) Announcements. Presenter: Michael Carroll**

68 Ida Fierro, Town Clerk stated the swimming pool is open from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Tuesday
69 thru Saturday.

71 Chief Julian Gonzales stated the Town of Bernalillo Police Department along with the
72 surrounding police departments received training on Active Shooter. It was held at the Bernalillo
73 High School. The goal of the training was to make sure they are all on the same page if a school
74 shooting were to happen. The training was great for all individuals involved. They are now
75 trained in what is considered the national standard in responding to school shootings.

77 There being no further business, Councilor Montoya moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:52 P.M.
78 The motion was seconded by Councilor Jaramillo and carried unanimously.
