

43 **WHEREAS**, obtaining the 1,500 acres would allow the San Antonio de Las Huertas
44 Land Grant to protect the land and water they have been given stewardship over,
45 educate others of history of the land grant and create homes for future generation of
46 their decedents;

47 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Governing Body of the Town of
48 Bernalillo supports the proposed Bureau of Land Management Development Plan for
49 the 1,500 acres that is us up for disposal from the Bureau of Land Management Land
50 also known as the Buffalo Tract.

51 **SECTION 1. Proposal**

- 52 1. A Solar Farm Development to generate revenue not only for the Historical Museum and
53 recreational development, but revenue for our grant. The solar farm will generate
54 electricity for 7,400 households and provide clean energy for generations to come.
55 2. A recreational development with trails for hiking, and exercise circuit and designated
56 areas where families can come and picnic. The picnic location will have structured
57 covering, a grill for cooking and a table.
58 3. A Historic working museum that will educate others of our past. This will include
59 community workshops, gardens and orchards. It is also our vision to incorporate several
60 of the feral horses into the working village.
