48 \$1,290,000.00 from previous estimate of \$600,000.00 and reauthorization of \$195,000.00
49 2014 Legislative Appropriation earmarked for Rio Grande waterline crossing.

51 • Drainage Plan and Stormwater Improvement ESCAFCA. Ranked in 2018 at #3
52 -update to reflect a \$40,000.00 contribution towards construction of project to be identified in the
53 drainage plan. This project is currently shown only as “supporting” project. Dept. of Finance is
54 no longer accepting projects in the ICIP without financial contribution. & \$40,000.00 is 10% of
55 ESCAFCA’s 2018 ICIP projected expenditure in the Town.
