Due to the audit findings that the Town has had on its audits since 2007. The Town is making corrective entries which will make next year's audit much better. The only new audit exception was two items that were over budget the Fire Department and Coronado Campground funds.

JJ Griego commended the staff and their cooperation in providing them with all the information to complete the audit in a timely manner. JJ Griego looks forward to working with the Town for the 2016 Audit preparation and completion.

WHEREAS, the Town of Bernalillo Town Council of the Governmental Unit ("the Governing Body") desires to submit an Application for financial assistance from the Fund for a Planning Document, as defined in the Rules Governing the Local Government Planning Fund currently in effect and as specifically identified below, for the benefit of the Governmental Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body intends to submit the Planning Document to develop an

economic development plan for the benefit of the Governmental Unit and its citizens; and WHEREAS, the application prescribed by the Finance Authority to finance the Pla

WHEREAS, the application prescribed by the Finance Authority to finance the Planning Document to develop an economic development plan for the benefit of the Governmental Unit and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the application prescribed by the Finance Authority to finance the Planning Document in whole with financial assistance from the Fund has been completed, submitted to, and reviewed by the Governing Body, and this Resolution approving submission of the completed Application to the Finance Authority for its consideration and review is required as part of the Application.
