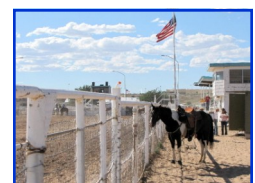

The Town of Bernalillo has some new employees.

Tony C'de Baca is the Infrastructure Administrator. He is in charge of Public Works, Planning, Building Safety and Zoning.
