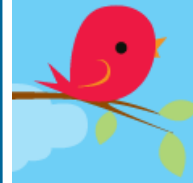

### COLD WEATHER PET CARE



#### Keeping pets safe in cold weather

The following are tips to keep your pets safe during the cold winter months:

##### Indoor pet tips:

- During severe weather, dogs should be let out only to relieve themselves. Cats should be kept indoors at all times.

- After walking you dog, remove ice, snow, salt and caked mud from your pet's paws and coat immediately.
- Make sure your pet's bed is not on the floor in a cold or drafty area of your home.
- Indoor dogs typically receive less exercise during cold weather and therefore may require fewer calories; feed smaller portions in order to avoid weight gain.

##### Outdoor pet tips:

- All domesticated animals should be provided shelter from the elements. In severe weather, allow your pet to be in your house or garage.
- Outdoor pets typically need more food in cold weather because they must burn more calories to keep warm.
- Check for frostbite, especially on paws and ears.
- Make sure your pet's water is never frozen.
- Keep an eye out for and clean up all antifreeze spills—one lick of the sweet-tasting fluid can be fatal to an animal.
- Cats have been known to climb onto vehicle engines for warmth; knock on the hood of your car before starting the engine if you suspect your cat could be inside.

If you have additional questions or concerns about how to care for your pet in sub-zero temperatures, please check with your veterinarian.



## Library Corner

The library staff is happy to announce some new services for our community.



**Little Library Boxes.** These boxes have been put in three locations around town: Fred Saiz Memorial Park on Calle Placitas; at the cross-road of Gutierrez Road, Sanchez Avenue and Los Arboles Road; and the

new Athena Park on Athena Road. These boxes are stocked with great books for the taking. All we ask is that you replace the book(s) when you are done or replace it with another book. There are books for all ages.

**Library Reading Rooms.** There are two locations where you can sit and read. These reading rooms are stocked with more great books, just like the Little Library Boxes. The locations are: The Old Well House behind the Senior Center and PB & J and the Train Engine in Rotary Park.

For those community members that cannot get to the library, we will be happy to deliver books to your door. We will even pick them up when you are through with them.
