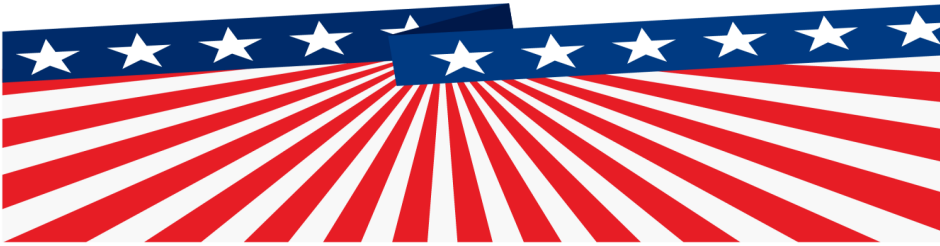

Ordinance No. 221 limits open burning and fireworks in the

In short, it limits the use of fireworks to safe and sane fireworks that can be used in areas that are paved or barren or that have a readily accessible source of water for use by the homeowner.



The Town of Bernalillo Water System will be conducting a Flushing Program during the coming months. Flushing the water main is a normal preventive maintenance procedure to improve water quality and test the system for fire flows.

Check the Town of Bernalillo's website for a list of frequently asked questions and answers, the areas involved and a schedule of when flushing will occur. Some areas may experience discolored or cloudy water during this time but this will be temporary. If this happens—run your water for a few minutes to clear.
