### ESCAFCA News

Progress on the South Hill Pond Modifications has been slower

than expected. The contractor encountered buried concrete rubble and more dirt to haul away, plus a very cramped work area. As a consequence, completion is now scheduled for the end of July, with most of the heavy work done by late June.

Later this summer, when the Town of Bernalillo goes to construction on the South Hill Road project, ESCAFCA will also bid a separate, but related project to allow drainage from the Town's South Hill Road to flow into Athena pond. Further details will come later.
