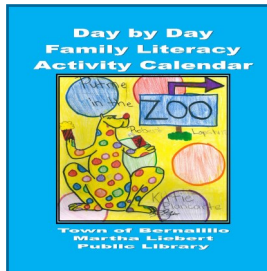

Bound for Success is a not for profit organization operating Nearly New, a repeat boutique, on Bernalillo's main street,

Camino del Pueblo, for more than fifteen years. Bound for Success provides clothing to women and men who are transitioning from welfare to work, home to work, victims of domestic abuse, and people who find themselves homeless or between shelters. Most clients of Bound for Success are minority female head of household with an annual income below \$10,000.00.

The boutique holds sales to benefit particular segments of the workforce, such as teachers with an annual "Back to School Staff Appreciation Sale", and provides clothing to clients of more than twenty-two agencies in Sandoval County including back to work programs, domestic violence shelters, and family service providers.

Bound for Success receives no public funding and relies on donations of clothing and retail sales in the nicely appointed boutique to support the program. Nearly New is open Tuesday-Saturday from 10:00am to 4:00pm. Tax deductible donations are accepted daily.
