## Planning and Zoning

The Town of Bernalillo is soliciting letters of interest from Bernalillo residents who wish to serve a two-year term as a Planning and Zoning Commissioner. Mayor Jack Torres and the Town Council will make four appointments to the Planning and Zoning Commission upon review of all letters of interest received.

The Planning and Zoning Commission consists of seven members, all of whom serve two year terms. The Planning and Zoning Commission meets on the first Tuesday of each month, and as may be additionally required to conduct business. The Planning and Zoning Commission is charged with the duties of enforcing and carrying out the provisions of all laws relating to planning, platting, and zoning with a general purpose of guiding and accomplishing the appropriate and positive physical development of the town. Commissioners are required to attend all trainings as scheduled by the Mayor and Governing Body.

Letters of interest may be submitted to Mayor Jack Torres, Town of Bernalillo, via mail to PO Box 638, Bernalillo, NM 87004 or delivered to Town Hall at 829, Camino del Pueblo between the hours of 8:00am-5:00pm. Letters of interest must be received by April 29, 2011.



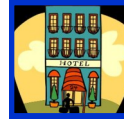

#### TOWN OF BERNALILLO LODGERS TAX FUND

The Town of Bernalillo will accept proposals submitted for the expenditure of Lodgers Tax funding until 3:00pm, Friday, April 29th, 2011. Proposals are to be submitted to Maria Rinaldi, Director of Planning and Capital Programs, Town of Bernalillo, 829 Camino del Pueblo, P.O. Box 638, Bernalillo, New Mexico 87004. Proposals must include the "Request for Funding" form that is available from the above referenced address between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm, Monday through Friday and on the Web at [www.townofbernalillo.org](http://www.townofbernalillo.org). It is the intent of the Town of Bernalillo to enter into one or more contracts for an aggregate sum of \$50,000 for one or more of the following purposes:

\*\*Advertising and promoting tourist facilities and activities through the design, production and placement of media advertisement.

\*\*Establishing, operating, constructing, purchasing, otherwise acquiring, reconstructing, bettering, or otherwise improving, equipping, and furnishing tourism facilities owned by the municipality.

\*\*Providing police and fire protection and sanitation services for tourist related events and attractions located within the town of Bernalillo proper.

The requests for funding will be evaluated based on eligibility, feasibility, and any prior performance of applicant (applies only to previously funded applicants). The Town Council will consider staff recommendations for funding at the regular Town Council meeting of May 9th, 2011.
