Household Hazardous Waste Collection @ The Sandoval County Landfill

May 6 and May 20
8:00 AM – 12:40 PM

This is a free service for Sandoval County residents; proof of residency is required. No commercial waste or large quantities of waste will be accepted.

To drop off household hazardous waste materials, county residents must preregister for a drop-off time by calling (505) 891-5015 (Monday-Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.). Drop-off times are provided on a first-come, first-served basis.

ESCAFCA welcomes new Board member Leroy Lovato. Mr. Lovato was appointed by Governor Martinez.

The ESCAFCA Board awarded a contract for the South Hill Pond Modifications to Sierra Valley Contractors, Inc. Sierra Valley Contractors plans to start work in late April, and will work four 10-hour days. Completion should be in mid May. Work will consist of repairing damage from the 2013 storms, expanding the size of the pond, and adding some controls to the outlet structure.

ESCAFCA also plans to advertise for bids for a combination desilting structure/ spectator seating in Athena Pond, plus a connecting storm sewer in Melissa Road from Athena Pond east to the Bernalillo Acequia, where it will connect to a storm drain system on South Hill Road to be built by the Town of Bernalillo.

Spring has sprung and so have the weeds!



Please take the time to maintain your property in compliance with Town of Bernalillo Ordinance No. 73 which requires that weeds in excess of four inches in height must be removed from the following areas:

- Within the front, rear or side yard setbacks of the property
- Between your property line and the middle of the alley adjacent to the property
- Between your property line and the curb
- The area ten feet outside the property line where there is no curb

Weeds always seem to crop up in these forgotten areas and it's important to remember that maintaining or cleaning-up the area between the wall or sidewalk and the curb and/or the alley is the responsibility of the property owner.

To report excessive weeds call Joe Benney, Building Inspector at the Town of Bernalillo at 771- 5882. Property owners with excessive weeds will be cited under Ordinance No. 73.
