## CORONADO LITTLE LEAGUE PROJECT

## TOWN OF BERNALILLO FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Town of Bernalillo's Fire Department recently completed a survey from Insurance Services Organization (ISO) that determines the Public Protection Classification for all fire departments. This classification is used in part by some insurance carriers to determine property insurance rates. The Fire Department improved from a class 6 to a class 5. Many areas of the fire department are reviewed to determine the classification, such as staffing, fire hydrants, training, equipment, water system and communications. Residents and businesses are encouraged to contact their insurance agent to see if this will result in a reduction of insurance premiums.
