Alarm Registration

The Town of Bernalillo Alarm Ordinance #227 requires that all residential and businesses with alarm systems register with the Town of Bernalillo Police Department. The ordinance is intended to better manage the number of "false" alarm responses handled by the police department. The permit is \$10.00 and the application is available at the police department, town hall, or can be downloaded at www.townofbernalillo.org.
