Call Before You Dig

Before you start any construction work, the law requires you to call the local "One Call" center to tell them when and where you plan to dig—at least 48-72 hours in advance. New Mexico One Call is a free service. The number is 1-800-321-2537.

Local utility companies including the Town of Bernalillo Water Department will be dispatched to the site and personnel will mark the location of the utilities. Color coded spray paint or flags on the surface identify the type of underground service. You can then dig safely!

Failure to comply with the New Mexico excavation law is subject to a penalty up to \$5,000.00 for the first offense and up to \$25,000.00 for each subsequent violation. Additionally, if you dig before contacting One Call, you could face liability damages if a utility line is cut.

Did You Know?

If you are operating a store-front, home based, or any other business within the Town of Bernalillo, you are required to register your business with the Town Clerk and obtain a business license. The annual fee is \$35.00. A NM CRS ID number and copy of the NM PRC certificate is required.

Animal Control

The Town of Bernalillo Animal Control officer reminds residents that the town does have an ordinance relating to animals. Licenses may be obtained at Town Hall at 829 Camino del Pueblo.

- Residents may have up to 5 dogs or cats in any combination. Dogs must have the license tag attached to them.
- All dogs and cats must have a valid rabies vaccination from a licensed veterinarian.
- Animals are prohibited from running at large within the Town limits.

The Town of Bernalillo Animal Control officer patrols the community on a regular basis and violations of the ordinance can result in a citation to municipal court. Fines can be up to \$300.00 for each violation.
