Coronado Campground

The Coronado Campground is a jewel in the crown of historic Bernalillo. Located on the bluff above the ancient Rio Grande, the Campground overlooks the Bosque or river forest, the foothills beyond, and towering above all, is the majestic northwest face of the Sandia Mountains. Located adjacent to Coronado State Monument and Santa Ana Golf Course, the campground features Main and North overnight camping areas. Both areas are open year-round with the exception of the North tent area which is only open from March 1—September 30. Each area has access to toilets, showers, water, electricity, dump station, trail connections to the river, a volleyball pit; and, shelters and beautiful views!

The standard fees for camping at the Main area are \$20.00-\$22.00 per day. The fees range from \$10.00 for tent sites; \$13.00 for the shelter sites; and, group shelters for those special gatherings are available in both areas for a \$10.00 non-refundable reservation fee, a \$42.00 user fee, and a \$20.00 refundable damage deposit.

If you are looking for somewhere special to eat your lunch or take a moment for yourself, you can utilize the campground for a Day Use or Picnic Fee of only \$1.00 per hour, or \$8.00 per day.
