Keep Bernalillo Beautiful

The Town will sponsor the annual "Keep Bernalillo Beautiful" campaign, in conjunction with the Great American Cleanup on May 12 and May 13. Bernalillo residents can take one pick-up or trailer of garbage to the Sandoval County Landfill on May 12th from 8:00 a.m.—12:00 noon at no charge. Just provide proof of Bernalillo residency, such as water, or other utility bill with a physical address. The landfill will not accept appliances, tires, or hazardous chemicals such as motor oil, paint, etc.

Mayor Patricia A. Chávez encourages civic groups, neighborhoods, and citizens to participate in the town cleanup. To facilitate community participation, the Town will provide dumpsters at the following areas for residents to dump non-prohibited items. The location of the dumpsters will be:

- Corner of Athena Street and Melissa Street in Mountain View Estates
- Corner of Calle del Bosque and San Lorenzo in the Sawmill District

Lodgers Tax Proposals

Mayor Patricia A. Chávez is pleased to announce that the Town of Bernalillo is accepting proposals for the expenditure of Lodgers Tax funds until 5:00 p.m., Friday, May 4, 2007. Proposals are to be submitted to Maria Rinaldi at the Town of Bernalillo, 829 Camino del Pueblo, P.O. Box 638, Bernalillo, New Mexico 87004. Proposals must include the "Request for Funding" form. The form is available at Town Hall between the hours of 8:00 a.m.—5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The Town of Bernalillo is posed to enter into multiple contracts for an aggregate sum award of \$50,000.00. Mayor Chávez asked that all entities engaged in advertising, promoting, and improving Bernalillo tourist facilities or activities are eligible to submit proposals to be evaluated for a funding award. "The more proposals the better", states Mayor Chávez. "This helps diversify the way these taxpayer dollars are spent. Again, deadline is close of business, Friday, May 4, 2007 for submitting a proposal with the completed, required form.
