Looking For Water Rights

Mayor Patricia A. Chávez and staff are working hard to ensure that community drinking water supplies are adequate to meet future needs. To that end, the Town seeks to purchase additional water rights from individuals who are interesting in selling them.

To qualify for consideration, the water rights must have been put to beneficial use prior to 1907 and cannot be Conservancy District rights. Purchases will be made at the current market rate, to be determined by the Town jointly with its water rights consultant.

Housing Cleanup

This summer, citizens of the Town of Bernalillo can expect to see some positive changes to the appearance of our public housing neighborhood. The Town of Bernalillo Housing Services announce that the public housing units are receiving a serious facelift this summer. A multi-step campus wide cleanup will begin to transform the neighborhood.

Efforts are now underway to remove dead or overgrown weeds, tree branches, and bushes from all common areas including the open field on the west side of the housing development. The initiative will also remove unwanted furniture, disabled cars, trash and debris from within the private yards of each unit. Painting and exterior updates of the homes and administration building will follow.

This project is being funded by a grant from HUD for capital improvements and is wholeheartedly supported by Mayor Patricia A. Chávez and the town council.

Children + Hot Cars = Danger

The Town of Bernalillo Fire Department personnel recommend keeping children safe in cars this summer by using common sense and taking some extra safety precautions:

- Never leave a child alone in a car—even with the windows down. The inside of a car can heat up quickly to temperatures that could hurt or kill a child.
- Always lock car doors and trunks and keep keys of children's reach. Children could get into the car and get trapped.
- Ensure all children leave the car when you reach your destination. Remember to remove sleeping infants and children in car seats.
- If your car has been parked outside on a hot day, make sure the car seat and seat belts are not too hot before buckling your children in the car. Severe burns can occur.
- Rising temperatures inside a car can cause a child to suffer from heat stress, dehydration and even shock. Carry plenty of water or other fluids when traveling with children to prevent them from dehydrating.
