Meet your Recreation Department



The Recreation Department is made up of four full time employees; Jason Soto, Recreation Director and Recreation Aides, Louie Duran, Zachary Chavez and Trey Darnell.

During the summer season, we hire an additional eight people to help run the Camp Coronado Summer Recreation program and four or five lifeguards.

The Recreation Center is located at Rotary Park.



Q. What are the operating hours at the Recreation Center?

A. The Recreation Center is open from 8am to 8 pm, Monday through Friday.

Q. Can we use one the Recreation Center for a special event?

A. Yes the Recreation Center is available for athletic events, family outings, and special events. If you would like to use the Recreation Center for a special event, you may contact, the Recreation Director, Jason Soto at (505) 238-0689 for availability.

Q. Do you have a youth recreation program?

A. Yes. Every year the Town of Bernalillo hosts a youth summer program called Camp Coronado for children from ages five to fourteen. The program runs from June 3rd to August 2nd. The camp is limited to 150 children and registration has already started.

Q. What can you do at the recreation center?

A. We have a gym and a fitness center available for your use. We also have a game room. Among the many games you can play in the gym are basketball, volleyball, and pickleball. The fitness center is equipped with everything you need to keep your body fit.

Since the incorporation of the Town of Bernalillo in 1948 there has always been a recreation program to provide all residents with social and recreational programs.

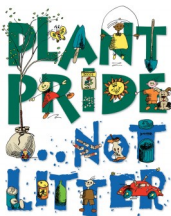


Great "Litter"ature at the Town of Bernalillo Martha Liebert Public Library. Available now!

It's important to take pride in our Town and keep it clean. Here are some simple things you can do to keep Bernalillo beautiful;

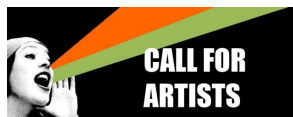
- Don't toss trash out the car window

ORDINANCES

Two ordinances govern weed and litter control in the Town of Bernalillo. Ordinance Nos. 73 and 74 are the Weed and Anti-Litter ordinances respectively. Property owners with excessive weeds, litter or junk on their properties may be cited under these ordinances.

ESCAFCA's Athena Pond nears completion

Installation of storm drains in the streets surrounding Athena Pond has been going strong.

After the storm drains are installed, six street lights will be installed around the pond area. They will be the same style as the new ones along Camino del Pueblo. Also, all the streets torn up for the storm drains will be repaved

Water infiltration galleries [chambers] have been installed in the deepest part of the "hole" at the north end, and covered with rock and fabric. These will allow stormwater that flows into the pond to infiltrate into the groundwater. This area will be covered with soil, and along with all other areas, will be re-seeded with a grass seed suitable for parks. An irrigation system will also be installed, so it will be important to keep vehicles off the area.

Chain link fence will go up along the south and east sides of the pond /park, and a post-and- cable barrier will be installed on the north and west sides, but there will be adequate parking available.

All work should be finished in late May, so the Athena Pond will be ready for the upcoming storm season. Hopefully, there will be one!
