


**Bernalillo Youth Basketball Program**

**Are you ready for *Coming Flu* on Oct 1 at the Library?**

J.L. (Janet) Greger, a resident of Bernalillo, will talk about "Science in fiction" and sign copies of her new novel *Coming Flu* at 1 on Saturday, October 6 at the Town of Bernalillo Martha Liebert Public Library.

a flu epidemic breaks out in a small walled community near Albuquerque. More than two hundred die in less than a week. The rest face a bleak future when quarantine is imposed. One resident, Sara Almquist, a medical epidemiologist, pries into every aspect of her neighbors' lives looking for ways to stop the spread of the flu. She finds promising clues - maybe too many.

Janet, in her talk, will answer questions like: Could scientists now make Harry Potter's invisibility cloak? And would it be possible to clone a dinosaur, as done in *Jurassic Park*? And could a flu virus be deadly like in *Coming Flu*?

As an experienced professor, she'll make science interesting. She's also bringing Bug, the one character in *Coming Flu* based on a live "individual." In real life, Bug is a pet therapy dog who regularly visits sick children at UNM Hospital and patients at the VA Hospital.
