AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 118

This _____ Amendment to Ordinance No. 118 Effective May 27, 1997

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE TOWN OF BERNALILLO, SANDOVAL COUNTY, NEW MEXICO:

AMENDED SECTION 1: DEFINITIONS.

- F. "roadside", means location in front of residence where container is to be placed no more than four (4) feet from the road with handles of receptacle facing the house. Receptacle is to be four (4) feet from any fixed object on collection day (i.e., mailbox, vehicle, etc).

AMENDED SECTION 2: CONTAINERS FOR SOLID WASTE.

- A. Contractor shall provide one 96 gallon receptacle, frontload or roll-off container depending on volume for each owner, occupant, tenant or leasee using or occupying any premises within the boundaries of the municipality and which shall be used by said owner, occupant, tenant, or leasee using or occupying any premises within the boundaries of the municipality.
- B. Garbage containers shall be provided to the owner or occupant of each residence or establishment sufficient in number to accommodate such waste generated by the residence or establishment between collections. Containers shall be of durable metal or plastic or rubber, water-tight, non-absorbent, rust-resistant, rodent-proof, and easily cleanable. They shall be equipped with handles and tightly fitted covers and shall have a capacity of not less than 96 gallons except that bulk containers of a type accepted by the Municipality as suitable for mechanical collection by equipment used for such collection may be used. Containers failing to comply with these provisions or which have defects causing them to scatter waste upon the ground during collection or causing them to hamper or to injure the persons collecting waste shall be promptly replaced.
1. Additional receptacles will be provided upon request to residents with additional trash for a fee to ensure all trash is contained in receptacles. Solid waste that does not fit inside any container must make arrangements for removal through Contractor for a fee.
- C. No person shall dump or deposit, or cause to be dumped or deposited, any garbage in boxes or bins designated for rubbish including paper, glass or metal containers which have been saturated with or still contain organic wastes that may attract insects or rodents, or generate noxious or offensive gases or odors.


- D. It shall be unlawful to burn solid waste of any nature within the Town of Bernalillo. Tumbleweeds may be burned with the permission of the Town Fire Department.
- E. All commercial and industrial establishments and apartment complexes will have a minimum, (1) one receptacle (polycart). An establishment generating 1 yard or more per week will be required to obtain a frontload container from the Contractor.

AMENDED SECTION 6: FREQUENCY OF COLLECTION.

A. Collection Points, Hours of Collection.

Residential - "Roadside" collection - trash receptacles polycart to be placed roadside accessible to Contractor's vehicle. Collection will occur one (1) time per week. Trash will be roadside by 7:00 a.m. Receptacles are to be removed roadside on collection day by 8:00 p.m. Receptacle is to be placed roadside in front of house and 4 feet away from any fixed object on collection day.
