ORDINANCE NO. 163

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 66 AND 152, TO ADJUST SEWER RATES

WHEREAS, Ordinance Nos. 66 and 152 were passed by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Bernalillo, County of Sandoval, State of New Mexico, on January 21, 1981 and October 28, 1996; and,

WHEREAS, the periodic revision of monthly rates, charges and conditions for sewer services furnished by the municipality is essential for the preservation and maintenance of a municipal water and sewer system; and,

WHEREAS, an amendment to portions of said ordinance is necessary in order to provide for the needs of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF BERNALILLO, COUNTY OF SANDOVAL, STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION ONE

ORDINANCE NO. 66, ARTICLE TWO, SECTION ONE, ENTITLED "MONTHLY SEWAGE RATES", is hereby amended to read as follows (with changes made, indicated by underlining):

SECTION ONE - MONTHLY SEWAGE RATES: The following monthly rates, charges and conditions for sewage service is hereby adopted:

<u>Residential</u>	
In - Town	\$ <u>13.79</u>
Out-of-Town	\$ <u>18.99</u>
<u>COMMERCIAL</u>	
In - Town	\$ <u>22.74</u>
Out-of-Town	\$ <u>32.42</u>
<u>SPECIAL</u>	
In - Town	\$ <u>106.15</u>
Out-of-Town	\$ <u>154.63</u>
<u>PUBLIC HOUSING</u>	\$ <u>1048.74</u> (Minimum for 304,000 gallons per month.)


For each additional one thousand (1,000) gallons or portion thereof, residential users, educational facilities, and public housing will be assessed at \$0.84 per one thousand (1,000) gallons during the winter months of December, January and February only. For the remaining months of the year (March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October and November), the sewage rates will be assessed at the rate of the average sewer use billing for the three (3) winter months mentioned above, for each sewer user. For each additional one thousand (1,000) gallons, or portion thereof, commercial and special users (except educational facilities and public housing) will be assessed at \$0.84 per one thousand gallons.
