PRESS RELEASE: 550 Construction Related Water Shutdown

Bernalillo, NM – March 16, 2020

A scheduled shut down of water services for the continuation of the U.S. 550 construction will take place, please see below:

Monday, March 16, 2020 from 2:00pm to 4:00pm

Area affected will include:

**Westside of Camino del Pueblo (NM 313), between U.S. 550 to the Family Dollar
Entire Riesling Road Subdivision**

The Town of Bernalillo and FNF Construction will be connecting to the new water main installed as part of the U.S. 550 project. It is the chief concern for both the Town of Bernalillo and FNF Construction that residents and businesses are provided with water in a timely and safe manner.

During this utility line changeover, it is expected that residents in the areas described above will experience low to no water pressure during time period. All water pressure is expected to be restored by 4:00 p.m on Monday, March 16, 2020. The Town of Bernalillo would like to thank our residents and businesses for their continued patience during this necessary transition as construction continues along the U.S. 550 corridor.

Whenever a water main break or maintenance occurs, it is possible for some residents to see discoloration or sediment in their drinking water after the repair. The Town of Bernalillo is actively monitoring water quality, and at this time has found no reason for concern about water quality in its service area. If this occurs, please run your faucets until the discoloration clears.
