## UTILITY LINES TO BEGIN MOVING FOR NM HIGHWAY 550 CONSTRUCTION

**Bernalillo, NM January 24, 2020** – On Tuesday, January 28, 2020, between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., the Town of Bernalillo and FNF Construction will be connecting to the new water main installed as part of the U.S. 550 project.

As a result, many residents will experience low to no water pressure during this overnight time period. We encourage residents in the area to make any necessary preparations. All water pressure is expected to be restored by 5:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 29, 2020. Currently, we are expecting a significant number of residents on the east side of the river to experience low to no water pressure. The Town of Bernalillo would like to thank our residents and businesses for their continued patience during this necessary transition as construction continues along the U.S. 550 corridor.

Whenever a water main break or maintenance occurs, it is possible for some residents to see discoloration or sediment in their drinking water after the repair. The Town of Bernalillo is actively monitoring water quality, and at this time has found no reason for concern about water quality in its service area. If this occurs, please run your faucets until the discoloration clears.
