UPDATE: SCHEDULED MOVE OF UTILITY LINES FOR U.S. 550 CONSTRUCTION HAS BEEN TEMPORARILY CANCELLED

Bernalillo, NM – January 30, 2020

Transfer of water utilities to the new main line will be delayed. **No date has yet to been set for when the water main transfer will happen. *As soon as the new date is set for the water utility transfer, the Town of Bernalillo will alert the general public immediately.***

The Town of Bernalillo will once again give the public ample notice of the expected change over once information is received from NMDOT and FNF Construction. The Town wishes to thank every resident and business for their patience while necessary preparations are made for a clean move of the water utility line during this project.

The expected areas affected during this change over will include U.S. 550 between NM 313 (Camino Del Pueblo) and Camino Don Tomas, the west side of NM 313 (Camino Del Pueblo) between US 550 and Calle Del Norte, as well as Riesling Road on the east side of NM 313.

The Town of Bernalillo and FNF Construction will be connecting to the new water main installed as part of the U.S. 550 project. It is the chief concern for both the Town of Bernalillo and FNF Construction that residents and businesses are provided with water in a timely and safe manner.

During this utility line changeover, it is expected that residents in the areas described above will experience low to no water pressure during this overnight time period. **We encourage residents living in and near the affected areas described to make any necessary preparations.** All water pressure is expected to be restored by 5:00 a.m. on Friday, January 31, 2020. The Town of Bernalillo would like to thank our residents and businesses for their continued patience during this necessary transition as construction continues along the U.S. 550 corridor.

Whenever a water main break or maintenance occurs, it is possible for some residents to see discoloration or sediment in their drinking water after the repair. The Town of Bernalillo is actively monitoring water quality, and at this time has found no reason for concern about water quality in its service area. If this occurs, please run your faucets until the discoloration clears.
