25 **APPROVAL OF AGENDA: 4a)**

26 Councilor Montoya requested that item 7a) Discussion on Curb Side Chat A candid Talk About

30 Councilor Montoya moved to approve the agenda as amended. The motion was seconded by

92 Maria Rinaldi indicated that there was going to be hard compacted surface area that will lead to
93 the rest rooms.

95 **MISCELLANEOUS SECTION: 9c) Announcements. Presenter: Mayor Torres**

96 Mayor Torres announced the following:

98 Mayor Torres stated that the Town has imposed a no burn due to extreme fire danger. Each
99 member of the governing body was given a copy of Ordinance 241 which allows the Town to
100 impose no open burning and ban certain types of fireworks due to extremely high fire hazard due
101 to severe drought conditions.

103 Michael Carroll, Fire Chief stated that until the ban is lifted the Town will not issue burn permits
104 due to the extremely high fire danger. Fireworks cannot be completely banned, but allowed are
105 safe and sane fireworks. All fireworks stands will be inspected by the Fire Department to insure
106 that only safe and sane fireworks are being sold in the Town of Bernalillo. On the 4th of July staff
107 and volunteer fire fighters will be driving throughout the Town to issue citations for individuals
108 having illegal fireworks or open flames.

110 Maria Rinaldi announced the 4th of July celebration in Rotary Park from 2:00 p.m. to dusk. Also
111 on the 13th of July from 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. there will be a Hip Hop dance in the covered
112 area at Rotary Park.

114 Juan Torres, Treasurer stated that the auditors are here performing their field work for the 2011
115 audit.

117 Councilor Montoya thanked the Fire Department and the Police Department for the great job
118 they did for the Retired Fire Chief Eddie Marquez funeral.

120 Councilor Sisneros stated he saw the news report on Camp Coronado. It was a very positive
121 broadcast for the Town of Bernalillo.

123 Ida Fierro stated that there are 175 children enrolled in Camp Coronado. The staff is doing a
124 great job and thanked the Governing Body for allowing her to hire the individuals that are
125 currently camp host.

127 Mayor Torres wished to express the Governing Body's appreciation for a job well done to the
128 staff at Camp Coronado.
