



46 water structures designed to protect the public; and

47  
48 WHEREAS, without assistance the Town does not have the resources to  
49 completely and effectively address continued severe weather events; and

50  
51 WHEREAS, the rainfall and flooding damage has resulted in undue  
52 human suffering and hardship and threatens the safety, health, welfare,  
53 and well-being of approximately 100-200 households and,

54  
55 WHEREAS, all locally available public and private resources and forces available  
56 to mitigate and alleviate the damage are deemed insufficient to cope with the  
57 resulting situation, initiate repairs, and meet restoration requirements;

58  
59 Now, therefore, I, Mayor Jack Torres, by virtue of the authority vested in the  
60 Office of Mayor and by the New Mexico Civil Emergency Preparedness Act  
61 (NMSA 1978, 12-10-01 to 12-10-11) do hereby declare the Town of Bernalillo  
62 to be an emergency area for the purpose of exercising necessary emergency  
63 powers and expenditure of available resources, and requesting aid, assistance,  
64 and relief programs and funds available from the State of New Mexico.

65  
66 Mayor Torres entertained a motion.

67  
68 Councilor Sisneros moved to approve the adoption of Resolution 07/27/13 Emergency/Disaster  
69 Declaration. The motion was seconded by Councilor Prairie.
