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47 WHEREAS, there has been damage to public infrastructure including streets,
48 roads, and storm water structures designed to protect the public; and
49

50 WHEREAS, without assistance the Town does not have the resources to
51 completely and effectively address continued severe weather events; and
52

53 WHEREAS, the rainfall and flooding damage has resulted in undue
54 human suffering and hardship and threatens the safety, health, welfare,
55 and well-being of households in the Town of Bernalillo and,
56

57 WHEREAS, all locally available public and private resources and forces
58 available to mitigate and alleviate the damage are deemed insufficient to cope
59 with the resulting situation, initiate repairs, and meet restoration
60 requirements;
61

62 Now, therefore, I, Mayor Pro Tem Marian Jaramillo, by virtue of the authority
63 vested in the Office of Mayor and by the New Mexico Civil Emergency
64 Preparedness Act (NMSA 1978, 12-10-01 to 12-10-11) do hereby declare the
65 Town of Bernalillo to be an emergency area for the purpose of exercising
66 necessary emergency powers and expenditure of available resources, and
67 requesting aid, assistance, and relief programs and funds available from the State
68 of New Mexico.
69

70 Mayor Pro Tem Marian Jaramillo entertained a motion.

71
72 Councilor Prairie moved to approve the adoption of Resolution 09/17/13 Emergency/Disaster
73 Declaration. The motion was seconded by Councilor Montoya.
