83 Absentee Voting. Applications for absentee ballots may be obtained only from the office of the
84 Municipal Clerk. All applications for an absentee ballot must be completed and accepted by the Municipal
85 Clerk prior to 5:00 p.m., February 28, 2014. After 5:00 p.m. on February 28, 2014, all unused absentee ballots
86 will be publicly destroyed by the Municipal Clerk. The Municipal Clerk will accept completed absentee
87 ballots delivered by mail, or in person by the voter casting the absentee ballot, by a member of the voter's
88 immediate family, or by the caregiver to the voter until 7:00 p.m. on March 4, 2014.

90 **Absentee ballots may be marked in person in the office of the Municipal Clerk**
91 **during the regular hours and days of business, beginning on Tuesday, January 28, and**
92 **closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 28, 2014.**

94 **Early Voting. Early voting on paper ballots counted by (M100) electronic vote**
95 **tabulator will be conducted in the office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours**
96 **and days of business, beginning on Wednesday, February 12, 2014 and closing at 5:00 p.m.**

100 Clerk of Sandoval County not later than Tuesday, February 4, 2014 at 5:00 P.M., the date on which
101 the County Clerk will close registration books.

103 H. All Declarations of Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 7, 2014
104 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.

217 Mayor Torres made the following announcements;

219 Mayor Torres thanked staff for the efforts in making the legislative breakfast a success.

221 The two applications for Youth Core Conservation Program in the Town of Bernalillo were not
222 approved. We have been told we can appeal and trying to get information so we can appeal the
223 decision.

225 Mayor Torres stated there will be a presentation of the Sandoval County 10-year Economic
226 Development Assessment on November 25, 2013 @ 3:00p.m. at El Zocalo Event Center.
227

228 Mayor Torres read a letter sent to the Pueblo of Sandia so that the letter can be on record.
229

231 RE: Sandia Pueblo's Proposed Agreement with the Town of Bernalillo

232 Dear Mr. Mielke:

233 I forwarded to Mayor Torres your disappointing news that the Sandia Pueblo Council did not
234 approve the proposed agreement that we had worked out in which the Town of Bernalillo was to
235 provide, in addition to providing a positive civic environment in which the Pueblo can
236 operate a retail establishment selling primarily to Bernalillo residents, police and fire
237 protection services to the Ashley site in exchange for the Pueblo's yearly payment of \$25,000.00.
238 I further conveyed your message that the Pueblo was still willing to pay the amount of \$5,000.00
239 per year for those services. The Mayor has asked me to advise you that the Town cannot provide
240 those services for that amount. During the months of negotiation, documentation was
241 exchanged which reflected that the previous owners were paying between \$30,000.00 to
242 \$35,000.00 annually in various taxes. By accepting a payment of \$5,000.00 per year the Town
243 would essentially be subsidizing the Pueblo for the \$25,000.00 to \$30,000.00 loss. The Town is
244 not in a position to do so. Therefore, the Mayor has asked me to inform you that the Town will
245 not be providing those services to the Ashley site. Should the Pueblo's Council make a more
246 reasonable offer, it will certainly be considered by the Town.
247

248 The Mayor and I wish to thank you, the Governor and the Lt. Governor, for all the hard work in
249 arriving at the proposed settlement that was rejected by the Pueblo's Council.

254 Mayor Torres stated that we have sent our comments on the Trust status to Department of
255 Interior so that our position will be on record. I have told both Chiefs that we will not put anyone
256 in harm's way if the situation is life threatening. I have also told Chief Gonzales if someone needs
257 to be arrested BIA will have to take care of that it is \$67 a day for the cost to house an individual
258 in the Sandoval County Detention Center. The Town will not subsidize a for profit business that
259 is not paying taxes for services.
260

261 The Town received a letter from the Bureau of Interior Santa Ana Pueblo has requested that 78 ½
262 acres be granted Trust Status the area that is within the Town of that request is where GL Trees
263 and Ancient Spirits are. I have asked our Attorney to write a letter of protest. It is the same issue
264 it affects our gross receipt and revenue to the Town.
265

266 There are several new businesses coming into Town; Goodwill Industries will be placing a
267 location by Murphy's, Chili's, Little Caesars and Churches Chicken both by Kelly's Liquor.
268

269 There being no further business, Councilor Prairie moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:51

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270 P.M. The motion was seconded by Councilor Montoya and carried unanimously.
