70 playground at Rotary Park and shared a picture sent with the little children playing on the new

73 Mayor Torres attended the Sandoval County Planning and Zoning meeting there is a company by
74 the name of Sandridge that is proposing to place an exploratory well within the Rio Rancho City
75 limits. The well would be 2 miles from their water wells. There were 60 people to speak against
76 the well. There are too many unanswered questions about this project. January 28th there will be
77 another meeting on this issue. People talked about the dirt roads where the well would be and in
78 the event of an emergency it would be difficult for emergency vehicles to get to the location.

80 Mayor Torres stated that the New Mexico Transportation will be holding a meeting on December
81 17 at 6:30 on the 550 project from 313 to 528. The plan is to redo the bridge. We have asked
82 them to respect our business district. There is no simple solution. Please try to attend, the more
83 people we have representing Bernalillo the better it is for us.
