WE ARE HONORED TO INTRODUCE POLICE CHIEF BRODERICK SHARP

The Town of Bernalillo has appointed Broderick Sharp as the acting Police Chief for the Bernalillo Police Department. Broderick comes to Bernalillo with over 28 years of experience in military and civilian law enforcement. Most recently, he was working at the Bernalillo County Sherriff's Department where



he was a Capitan and the North Valley/Special Operations Commander, commanding a total of 59 assigned deputies.

Broderick graduated with honors from Wayland Baptist University, with a Bachelor's of Science in Justice Administration. He also attended Northwestern University Center for Public Safety, School of Police Staff and Command. Broderick began his journey in law enforcement as a Security Police Canine Handler in the United States Air Force in 1992, where he handled an explosive detector dog. Broderick served in Panama, Saudi Arabia (Khobar Towers Bombing) and Kuwait (Operation Enduring Freedom), Araxos Air Base, Greece and was assigned to Secretary of Defense William Cohen and President Bill Clinton's security detail. In May of 2000, Broderick began his career with the Sheriff's Department and ascended to the rank of Captain.

Other notable projects from Broderick include his work at the 2019 Legislative Session, where he was awarded \$702,000.00, for the appropriation of the newest Rook (armored safety vehicle) in the United States at that time. The equipment was purchased from Ring Power Corporation and has been used to bring a safe resolution to over twenty (20) SWAT activations in 2020.

Broderick is also highly involved with the Albuquerque Youth Basketball League, his Amateur Athletic Union team, Blackout 15U. Broderick coached junior varsity basketball at Manzano High and at East Mountain High School prior to that. During the summer of 2019, Broderick partnered with McDonald's and Raymond G. Sanchez Community Center to organize a summer lunch program, where students would get a lesson taught by Bernalillo County Sherriff's School Resource Deputies and a meal from McDonald's in five of their Albuquerque restaurants. The program was noted as a huge success and was adopted by Rio Rancho Police, Bernalillo Police, and the McDonald's Corporate Office participated in the awards ceremony. Broderick's work ethic, attitude and servant leadership has inspired numerous students to want to serve and make a difference in their community.

Chief Sharp officially begins his appointment at the Town beginning November 2nd. We are truly honored to have him leading the men and women of the Police Department and look forward to his leadership in keeping Bernalillo safe.

2020 ELECTION INFORMATION

The 2020 General Election is Tuesday, November 3rd. Voters can vote by mail, early in-person, or on election day.

IMPORTANT UPDATE ABOUT BUILDING PERMITS

The Town recently transitioned all permitting and inspections to the NM Construction Industries Division (CID). For current projects that have a building permit from the Town, fill out and hand deliver a Conversion Permit to CID at 5500 San Antonio Dr. NE in Albuquerque. CID charges a \$30 fee for conversion permits. Plan sets for on-going projects were delivered to CID on Sept. 25th. CID will conduct the remainder of building inspections. For trades permits from Rio Rancho, continue to contact them for inspections.

FOR NEW BUILDING PERMITS:

CONTRACTORS: For a NEW general construction permit, including porches, garages, carports, patios, portals, etc., fill out and submit a Building Permit Application and a copy of your building plans, to the Planning and Zoning Director at: sshumsky@townofbernalillo.org

Homeowners: For a NEW homeowners permit, fill out and submit a Homeowner Building Permit Application Packet and a copy of your building plans, to the Planning and Zoning Director at: sshumsky@townofbernalillo.org.

Town staff will conduct the zoning and floodplain review and contact you if additional information is needed. After the Town's review is complete, staff will email you the fee amount for the zoning and floodplain review and, once paid, will email you the signed application. Submit the signed application, 2 copies of your building plans, along with

any other required documents, to CID electronically via their website: www.rld.state.nm.us OR in person at: 5500 San Antonio Dr. NE in Albuquerque.

For all other applications, including manufactured/mobile home placement permits, go to the Planning and Zoning Department's Forms and Applications web page. Fill out and email your application to the Planning and Zoning Director at: sshumsky@townofbernalillo.org


